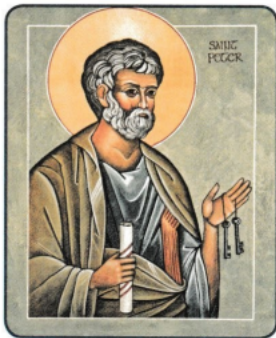

Feast of Divine Mercy

St. Peter's will be having the Divine Mercy Novena beginning on Good Friday, **AFTER** our 3:00 p.m. service, **concluding on Divine Mercy Sunday, April 27 at Blessed Sacrament Parish.**

Join our daily Divine Mercy devotion at 3:00 p.m.

Join us April 15 at 5pm at the Notre-Dame Cathedral to celebrate the **Christm Mass**. The Christm Mass is a special annual Mass where our Archdiocese gathers together to receive the new holy oils for the year. Priests renew their vows and the Archbishop blesses three different oils which are then distributed to parishes: the Oil of the Sick, the Oil of Catechumens, and the Sacred Christm.

On May 15th, 2025, our Archdiocese will gather to hear what God has done, what he is doing, and where he is leading us. Will you be there?

Mingle with others from Ottawa-Cornwall, hear live testimonies from people who encountered God, and be present for the official launch of our new Archdiocesan vision, presented by Archbishop Marcel Dampousse. Journey Through Lent—6

Welcome to Palm Sunday or Passion Sunday, the last week of our Lenten Journey, culminating with the passion, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ. This week is traditionally referred to as Holy Week. It is loaded with extraordinary liturgical activities to draw us deep into the Pascal Mystery. Palm Sunday celebration commemorates the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on a donkey as the crowd acclaims him as the awaited Messiah: "Blessed is the king who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest heaven." These joyful sentiments quickly faded away as soon as the soldiers arrested Jesus. He was humiliated, betrayed, and abandoned by even his apostles. Where do you locate yourself in the characters in the passion narrative - the crowd, soldiers, Pilate, elders and chief priests, the apostles, or the thieves crucified with him? Through how Jesus handled the last critical moments of his earthly life, we can draw profound lessons for spiritual growth. Although condemned unjustly to death for our transgression and brutalized by soldiers, Jesus boldly carried his cross to Calvary in obedience to the will of His Father. What crosses are in your life, and how graciously do you take them and offer them up for your sanctification? Jesus' three last statements from Luke's gospel reveal His mercy and total surrender to his Father's will: (1) Father, forgive them for they do not know what they are doing (Lk 23:34). This portrays the boundless mercy of God. (2) Today, you will be with me in paradise (Lk 23:43). Even at the very last moment, the mercy of God will see us through. A sincere prayer emanating from a contrite heart will lead us to the unfathomable mercy of God (3). Father, into your hands, I commend my spirit (Lk 23:45). Jesus totally entrusted his will to His Father, even at the darkest moment. As we come to the climax of this Holy Season, may God's mercy and compassion urge us on to true repentance and conversion as we surrender our wills, joys, and anxieties to God's hands. **Fr. Theo**

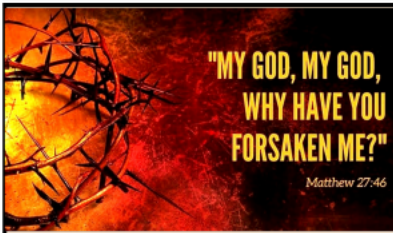
