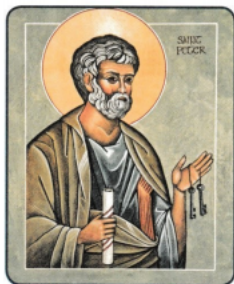

Flu Season Precautions for our Parish Communities
As we enter flu season, we want to ensure that our parishes remain safe and welcoming places for worship.

2. Pastoral Care: If you cannot attend Mass due to illness, we encourage you to participate via livestream.

4. Sign of Peace: A simple bow or verbal greeting is an acceptable alternative to a handshake during the Sign of Peace.
5. Reception of Holy Communion: Parishioners who are concerned about illness may receive Communion in the hand rather than on the tongue.
