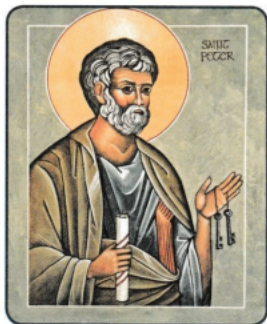

Just a few years ago, we had no seminarians in formation. Today, six men are preparing for the priesthood, and next year, we expect up to twelve. These vocations are a gift from God and a great sign of hope for our Church.

Each of these men has answered the call of the Good Shepherd with courage and faith. **Now we are invited to respond**, to walk with them and support their formation, especially their studies at the seminary, which costs around \$65,000 per seminarian, per year.

The Good Shepherd Sunday special collection will support the **Vocations Appeal**. Our goal this year is to raise \$500,000 to ensure that every seminarian receives the education and formation needed to serve God's people well and lead a Church that goes out, goes deep, and goes together.
