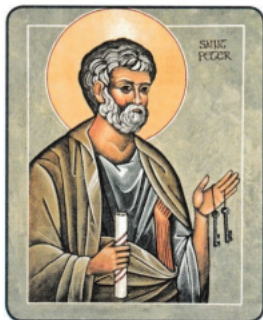

Plenary Indulgence for Divine Mercy Sunday

To ensure that the faithful observe this day with intense devotion, St. Pope John Paul II established a Plenary Indulgence to receive complete forgiveness and punishment, (as Jesus said), so that they might, in turn, show pardon to their brothers and sisters. Conditions to obtain the Plenary Indulgence are Reconciliation, Communion and Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father and take part in prayers and devotions in honour of Divine Mercy in any Church or Chapel.

The 9-day Divine Mercy Novena will begin on Good Friday and will be celebrated, at St. Peter's, daily, at 3:00 p.m.
