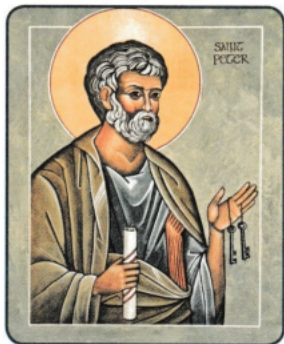

Gospel Reflection
