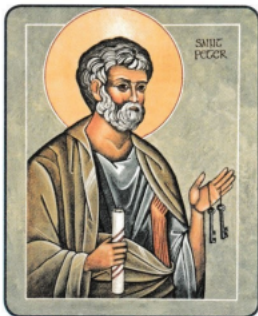

Gospel Reflection: "Fear No One"

"Fear no one." These reassuring words of our Lord resonate powerfully in our world today. We live in an age where faith is often marginalized, religious values are increasingly challenged, and Christian beliefs are frequently dismissed as outdated or irrelevant. In a culture shaped by relativism and radical individualism, the timeless truths of the Gospel can seem difficult to proclaim and even harder to live.

Yet, the human heart continues to hunger for meaning, peace, and authentic love. Despite unprecedented material progress, many find themselves spiritually thirsty, searching for fulfillment in places that cannot truly satisfy. The rejection of sacrificial love, rooted in the example of Christ, has left many feeling isolated and restless.

Into this reality, Jesus speaks once again: "Do not be afraid." He invites us to place our trust in Him, to surrender our fears, our plans, and our very lives into His loving hands. Christ reminds us that our worth comes not from the approval of the world but from the Father's love. We are known, cherished, and cared for by God, who watches over even the smallest sparrow. Whatever challenges you may be facing today—uncertainty, suffering, disappointment, anxiety, or discouragement—hear the voice of Jesus speaking directly to your heart: "Do not be afraid." In Him alone we find lasting peace, enduring hope, and true joy. May we have the courage to witness to our faith with confidence, knowing that the Lord walks with us always.
